
Six Men's Morris



Instructions

Each player needs 6 game pieces (the six men of the title).

- 1. Take turns **placing** one piece at a time on the board. You can only put the pieces on the dots.
- 2. After all your pieces are on the board, you can use your turn to **move** a piece along a line to an empty neighboring dot.
- 3. Both players try to make a *mill*, which is three men in a row along a straight horizontal or vertical line.
- 4. During both the placement and movement phases, whenever a player makes a mill, they remove one of the opponent's men that is **not** part of a mill, unless all the pieces are part of a mill.
- 5. You can only move your pieces along a vertical or horizontal line to get to the next empty dot, until...
- 6. When a player is down to 3 pieces, they may **fly** a piece to **any** empty dot.
- 7. The game is over when a player has 2 pieces left or cannot move, whereupon that player loses the game.
